2. Reason for announcement

NS United Kaiun Kaisha, Ltd. regards the return of profits to shareholders as one of its most important management policies, and its basic policy is to continuously return profits to shareholders in line with business performance while securing the necessary internal reserves to ensure stable future corporate growth and to respond to changes in the business environment. The dividend payout ratio relative to consolidated financial results is based on a payout ratio of 30%.

We have decided to pay a year-end dividend of 150 yen per share for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2024, an increase of 10 yen from the previous forecast of 140 yen per share, in consideration of the fiscal year results announced today.
