Ore Carrier NSU CARAJAS Collision with Other Vessels at Brazil

On November 28th, 2020, about 12:42 (local time), NSU CARAJAS (the vessel), an ore carrier owned and operated by our group, during berthing maneuver under pilotage, collided with two other vessels at the port of Ponta da Madeira, Northeast of Brazil.

According to reports from the vessel and local parties concerned, there is no casualties on board of those vessels nor to the people concerned, as well as no environmental damage. The details of this incident are currently under investigation.

We are fully cooperating with the investigation by authorities and parties concerned.
