## NSU Donates an Engine Room Simulator to Vietnam Maritime University

NS United Kaiun Kaisha, Ltd has donated a Full Mission Engine Room Simulator (FMS)\*<sup>1</sup> to Vietnam Maritime University (VMU) with the aim of contributing to the development of maritime professionals and enhancing the educational environment.

This simulator is an advanced training system capable of replicating an engine room environment similar to that of an actual vessel. It is expected to be used not only for practical training of students aspiring to become marine engineers, but also for the training of active seafarers to further improve their knowledge and technical skills, thereby contributing to the development of a wide range of maritime human resources.

At the commemorative ceremony held at VMU to mark the donation, both parties exchanged views on further strengthening cooperation toward the development of maritime professionals in the future.

\*1 Full Mission Engine Room Simulator (FMS): A training system that recreates ship engine room equipment and operational environments in conditions close to those of an actual vessel. It enables trainees to safely learn engine and generator operation management, as well as responses to abnormal situations, through simulation.
