## NSU Held Foreign Currency Coin Sorting Event for Social Contribution

We held a “Foreign Currency Coin Sorting Event” in the office during the lunch break on November 14, with the cooperation of the Japan Philanthropic Association and the Japan Habitat Association, both Public Interest Incorporated Associations.
